## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Northern Indiana Chapter of American Foundry Society will be offering financial grants to a child, grandchild or sponsored student of a chapter member. Qualifications required for this program are as follows:

1. Applicants must be a child/grandchild of a chapter member or be sponsored by a chapter member.
2. Applicants must be a High School Senior who will be enrolled as a College Freshman in the Fall of the upcoming academic year or a current College Student who will be enrolled in the Fall of the upcoming academic year.
3. Applicants must be enrolled in a foundry-related major; Engineering, Business, etc.
4. Applicants must submit a letter of recommendation from a Guidance Counselor or College Professor.
5. Awards will be based upon field of study, grade point average, work experience, and other considerations by the Chapter Board of Directors as may be deemed appropriate.
6. Winners of the scholarship financial assistance program will be selected from all of the applicants by the Board of Directors of the Northern Indiana Chapter, and their decision shall be final.

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
